The Subscriber Daniel Osborn of Baltimore County do make this my last will and Testament in manner following (to wit) I give and devise unto my son Joseph the sum of Twenty five pounds Current money and I give and devise unto my two sons John and Thomas the sum of fifty pounds Current money each I give and bequeath unto all my Children to be equally divided among them namely Joseph. Daniel. Sarah. Ruth. Rachel and Clara John and Thomas as all the Residue and Remainder of my Estate both real and personal to them their heirs and assigns forever after paying my debts Funeral Expences and the above Legacies. I do appoint and constitute my son Joseph Executor of this my last will and Testament In Witness whereof I do hereunto set my hand and Seal this 29th day of June 1790

entire Hundred and Ninety

and declared by the above named Testator to be his last will and Testament and subscribed by us in his presence and at his request.
