In the name of God, Amen. I Green Osborne of Pittsfield in the County of Merrimack State of New Hampshire, considering the uncertainty of this mortal life and being of sound and perfect memory do make and publish this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say—

First I give, bequeath and devise unto my beloved wife, Eight Hundred Dollars, and my claim for damages against the said Town of Pittsfield, to her and her heirs forever.

Second I give, bequeath and devise unto my children Elizabeth A., Charles B., Susan S., Mary P., Margaret, Warren S., Angelina A. and David S., to have and to hold to each respectively and their heirs respectively, one undivided Eighth part of all the residue,息 and remainder of my Estate wherever found and however situated after the payment of all my just debts and legacies

In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 19th day of November A.D. 1877.
