In the name of God Amen, Emily
Ozymon of the Borough of Bradenton
in the County of Burlington and
State of New Jersey, being of sound
and disposing mind memory and
understanding, for which blessing
I thank God, do publish this my
last will and Testament. in
First. I direct all my just debts to
be paid.

Second I give my servant Henry to my
brother Greenbank to serve him while
he lives and after my brothers death
I give my said servant his absolute
freedom.

Third I give and bequeath out of the
incomes rents and profits of my ~~real~~
estate to Sarah Emily Neighbours
the sum of four hundred and fifty
dollars annually, the first pay-
ment to commence in advance from
the date of my decease and so continue
until she arrives to the age of twenty
one year. And after the said Sarah
Emily Neighbours arrives to the age
of twenty one years I give and be-
queath her the sum of three hundred
dollars a year during her natural
life. I make the above legacy to her
a charge on my farm at Chancellors
point Talbot County in the state

of Maryland, as well as upon the whole of my estate. My desire being to secure her the above payments without fail.

Fourth. I desire that the said Sarah Emily Neighbours shall be thoroughly educated, and that she remain at the Bordentown Female College with Rev. John H. Brakely until she arrives to the age of Twentyone years, or for such time as the said Rev. John H. Brakely may think best. And for this purpose I appoint him guardian of her person.

Fifth. The balance of my estate as regards my personal property after making the above payments to Sarah Emily Neighbours, permanent and safe, I give to my brother Lewis and Greenbank, and my nephew John Henry Osmond.

Sixth. In case of the death of the said Sarah Emily Neighbours, I give my farm, and the rest of my estate (except my servant Henry), to my brother Lewis and Greenbank, and my nephew John Henry Osmond, and to their heirs, share and share alike.

Lastly, I do hereby appoint my friend Charles R. Mulliken executor

of this my last will and Testa-
ment, and Trustees of my estate
In witness whereof I have here
unto set my hand and seal

in the year of our Lord one thou-
sand eight hundred and fifty
eight..
