I Ethan Osborn of the townships of Fairfield, County
of Cumberland and State of New Jersey, do make,
publish and declare this for my last will and testament,
First, In consideration of the unremitting attention and
kind services of my friend Sarah M^cQueen I do give unto
her the said Sarah M^cQueen the use of my buildings and
cleared land with fire wood for one year after my death;
I also give to her the said Sarah the bedsted, bedding, drawers,
book case and furniture which her aunt Esther brought to my
house

Second, I give to Jane Ann Bateman (late M^cQueen) fifty
dollars,

Third, I give, bequeath and devise the residue of my
estate both personal and real to be divided equally
between the aforesaid Sarah M^cQueen; my son
John the children ^{my daughter} of Anna O. Lawrence, ^{the} children
of Ruth Thompson dec^d and my son Robert, making
five general shares, the children above mentioned taking two
of the general shares only; and further, out of the share
given to my son Robert I take one hundred dollars
and give the said one hundred dollars to my son in
law Benjamin Thompson

Fourth, I hereby authorize and empower my Executor to sell, either
at public or private sale, any part or all of my real estate and to make good
and sufficient conveyances of the same

Fifth, I hereby appoint Ephraim B. Whitecar to be my sole executor of this
my last will and testament, In testimony whereof I hereunto
set my hand and seal the twenty sixth day of October, A.D. 1850,
