memory do make and publish this my last Will and tes-  
tament. first I give and bequeath unto my Dear wife Mary  
all the Effects that she brought me, and one Chest one brass  
-kettle and Spining wheel also twenty five pounds in Cash  
and the Use of my bed and bedding belonging thereto and the  
Use of one Cow with pasture and provender for Sum-  
-er and winter as long as she remains my widow and  
lives in my Dwelling house. and provide she Chuse to  
quit my house and Relinquish her Right of Dower she  
shall have all that she brought and twenty five pounds  
in Cash one Chest one brass kettle and Spining wheel  
Item I give and bequeath unto my son Elias my Great Ch-  
-air and two Dollars and fifty Cents. Item I give &  
bequeath unto my son Henry two dollars and fifty  
Cents to him and his heirs forever. Item I give  
and bequeath unto my son John one Dollar to him  
and to his heirs for ever. Item I give and bequeath  
unto my son Eliphalet one Dollar to him and to his  
heirs forever. Item I give and Bequeath unto my  
Daughter Phoebe Creeker one Dollar to her and to  
her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto  
my Daughter Nancy Harrison one Dollar to her and  
to her heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto  
my Daughter Horeas twenty five Dollars to her and to her  
heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my  
Daughter Polly quel Ten Shillings to her and to her  
heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto my  
Daughter Sripheena Wilcocks two Dollars and fifty Cents  
to her and to her heirs forever. Item I give and be-  
queath unto my Daughter Olive my bed and Bedding  
belonging thereto by her paying to her Siffan Sripheena thir-  
-ty Shillings on his receiving the bed to her and to her  
heirs forever. Item I give and bequeath unto  
my son Jonathan Cossborn all my Real & personal  
Estate after my just Debts and funeral Charges  
are paid and the above Legacies are discharged to  
him and to his heirs forever. Lastly I do make  
Ordain Constitute and Appoint my two sons Elias and  
Jonathan Cossborn joint Executors of this my last will  
and testament and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke  
and disanul all and every other Testaments Wills

Legacies Bequests and Executors by me in any way men-  
tioned Willed and bequeathed Ratifying and Confir-  
-ing this and no other to be my last will and Testam-  
-ent in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and seal this twentieth day of february 1806
