of the City of Newark in the County of Essex and
State of New Jersey being of sound mind memory and
understanding for which blessing I do most devoutly
thank my God, but being weak in body, do make &
publish this my last will & testament, hereby revoking
all other & former last wills & testaments by me made
that is to say.

First It is my will and I do hereby order
that all my just debts & funeral expences be paid by
my Executor hereinafter named, as soon as conveniently
can be after my decease

Second I give devise and bequeath all the
rest residue & remainder of my estate both real
& personal of which I shall die seized & possessed or to
which I shall be entitled at the time of my decease
whenever the same may be, to my beloved wife
Keturah, to have & to hold the same to her & to her
heirs & assigns forever

Lastly I hereby appoint my beloved wife
Keturah aforesaid executrix of this my last will
and testament

hand & seal the third day of April in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & fifty
