In the name of God amen I Jesse Osborn of the
township of Amwell county of Hunterdon and
State of New Jersey being weak in body but
of sound mind and memory and understanding
do make and publish this my last will and testa-
ment in manner and form following viz—

First it is my will and desire that all my just
debts be duly paid and satisfied as soon as con-
venient after my decease

Second it is my will and desire that my mo-
-ther Opha Osborn and my sister Bernina Osborn
shall have at the house and lot of land whereon
I now dwell during my mothers natural life
and at the decease of my mother I gave and
bequeath said house and lot to my sister

Bernina Osborn ~~to~~ her heirs and assigns ^{forever}
Third I gave and bequeath my weavers loom and
tackling to my sister Bernina Osborn

Fourth all the remainder of my movable estate to be
sold as soon as convenient after my decease

Fifth if the money arising from the sale of my
movable estate should be insufficient to pay
all my debt and funeral expences then it is
my will that my real estat be sold by my
executor herein after named

Sixth and lastly I hereby appoints my truly friend
Joab S Merison executor of this my last will
(turn over)

and testament revoking all former wills and testa-
ments by me before made ratifying this and no
other to be my last will and testament

and seal ^{and seal} this ^{day of} fourteenth May one thousand eight hundred
and twenty eight.
