 each of our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these Presents. Dated the  
*15th* day of *June* 18*70*

The condition of this obligation is such, that if the above bounden *David Cavanagh*  
 shall well and faithfully execute  
 the trust reposed in *him* as Administrator  
 of all and singular, the goods, chattels and credits of *Thomas Osborn late*  
*of Buffalo N.Y.*  
 deceased intestate, and shall obey all orders of the Surrogate of Erie County, touching the administration of the  
 estate committed to *him* then this bond to be void, otherwise to remain in full force  
 and virtue.
