Know all men by these presents that we James R. Baldwin and Daniel Baker & Thos Pierce of the County of Champaign and State of Ohio are held and firmly bound unto David Vance Treasurer of Champaign County in the State of Ohio and his successors in office in the penal sum of three hundred Dollars for the payment of which well and truly to be made to the said Treasurer or his successors in office we bind ourselves our heirs Administrators or Executors jointly and severally firmly by these presents, as witness our hands and seals this eleventh day of April Eighteen hundred and twenty. The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound James R. Baldwin hath by the Court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid been appointed guardian of the person & property of Jeremiah Evert and Wilson Evert a minor orphan aged about fourteen years and an heir and legal representative of Jeremiah Evert late of said County deceased to serve and act as such according to law. Now if the said James R. Baldwin shall discharge with fidelity the trust reposed in him; and particularly that he render an accurate statement of his transactions with a just account of the profits arising and deliver the same to this Court at such time as they may require then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force & virtue.

Know all men by these presents that we William Osborn and John Winn of the County of Champaign and State of Ohio are held and firmly bound unto David Vance Treasurer of Champaign County in the penal sum of two hundred Dollars for the payment of which well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs Administrators and Executors firmly by these

presents. As witness our hands and seals this 28th day of August. AD 1820. The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas by the Court of Common Pleas of Champaign County aforesaid. the above bound William Osborn hath been appointed Guardian to the person and property of Belinda Osborn. orphan of the age of three years. minor heir & legal representative of Edward Osborn. deceased. late of this County deceased. to serve and act as such according to Law. Now therefore if the said William Osborn shall discharge with fidelity this trust reposed in him. and particularly that he render an accurate statement of his transactions with a just account of the profits arising. and deliver them up to the Court when he should be thereto required. then the above obligation to be void. otherwise to remain in full force & virtue signed sealed and acknowledged

Now therefore if the said Joshua Spain shall discharge with fidelity this trust reposed in him. and render an accurate
