


St Ledger Seal. Guardian of Rhua Pearce & Sarah Pearce

Know all men by these presents, that we St Ledger Seal and Aquilla Seal of the State of Ohio, and County of Champaign are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio in the penal sum of One hundred and fifty dollars, for the payment of which we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this 21<sup>st</sup> day of November eighteen hundred and twenty Eight. The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas by the court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid, the above bounden St Ledger Seal, hath this day been appointed guardian of the person and property of Rhua Pearce aged 16 years, and Sarah Pearce aged 12 years minor heirs and legal representatives of Thomas Pearce late of said County deceased. Now if the said St Ledger Seal, shall well and truly perform and discharge all and singular the duties required of him by law as guardian as aforesaid, and render to the Court when he shall be thereunto required, an accurate statement of his proceedings relative to the Estate of his said Wards together with the profits arising therefrom, then the above obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in force & virtue

Know all men by these presents that we James Osborn and James Dunlap sen. of the State of Ohio, and County of Champaign are held and firmly bound unto the State of Ohio, in the penal sum of Two hundred and fifty Dollars, for the payment of which we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 24<sup>th</sup> day of November eighteen hundred and twenty Eight. The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas, by the Court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid the above bounden hath this day been appointed Guardian

of the persons and property of David Osborn aged about 18 years. Lucretia Osborn aged about 15 years. Noah Osborn aged 13 years. Abram Osborn aged 9 years. Nancy Osborn aged 6 years. minor heirs and legal representatives of James Osborn late of said County deceased. Now if the said shall well and truly perform and discharge all and singular the duties required of him by law as guardian as aforesaid. and render to the Court when he shall be thereunto required. an accurate statement of his proceedings relative to the estate of his said wards together with the profits arising therefrom. then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in force and virtue



The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas by the Court of Common Pleas of the County aforesaid the above bounden David Hurley hath this day been appointed guardian of the person and property of Anna Mariah Downs aged over 12 years. minor heir and legal representative of William Downs late of said County deceased. Now if the said David Hurley shall well and truly perform and discharge all and singular the duties required of him by law as guardian as aforesaid. and render to the Court when he shall be thereunto required. an accurate statement of his transaction. proceedings. relative to the estate of his said wards together with the profits arising therefrom. then the above obligation to be void otherwise to remain in force and virtue
