
Know all Men by these Presents: That I Anna
 Osborn, widow and relict of Benjamin Osborn
 deceased for and in Consideration of
 the sum of Fifty one dollars of lawful
 money of this State to me in hand the
 said Anna Osborn by Isaac Elston and
 Calvin Riggs well and truly paid, the receipt
 whereof I do hereby acknowledge, I have
 renunced released and forever quit Claimed
 and by these presents do renunc, release
 and forever quit Claim unto the said
 Isaac Elston and Calvin Riggs all, and
 all manner of dower, & right and title
 of Dower whatsoever which I the said
 Anna Osborn now have, may, might,
 should, or of right ought to have claim
 of in or out of all and every the man-
 ners messages, lands, tenements and
 hereditaments which were belonging
 to the said Benjamin Osborn my hus-
 band deceased at any time during the
 coverture between him and me the said
 Anna Osborn situate lying in the County
 of Clermont & State of Ohio, or elsewhere
 and also all manner of action or actions
 writ or writs of Dower whatsoever so
 as neither I the said Anna Osborn
 nor any other person for me or in
 my name any manner of Dower or
 writ of action of dower or any writ
 or title of dower of or in the said
 manners, lands, tenements, and heredit-
 aments, or of or in part or parcel
 thereof at any time hereafter.
 Shall or may have claim or prosecute a-
 gainst the said Isaac Elston & Calvin
 Riggs their heirs and assigns.

Witnesseth that the said Willis for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by said Sell, the receipt Where... is hereby acknowledged hath given, granted, Bargained & Sold & by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Sells a tract or parcel of land containing One hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less.

Situate lying & being in Clermont County State of Ohio, it being part of a Military tract of One thousand acres (Warrent No. 2270 in favor of Stephen Southal) 500 acres of which said
