



Know all Men by these Presents: that

I David Osburn of County of Clermont and State of Ohio have remised, released, and forever, quit, claim, and by these presents do for me my heirs, executors, administrators, remise, release, and forever quit, claim, unto the estate of Benjamin Osburn my father Deceased of the County and State aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators all and all manner of action, and actions cause and causes of actions, duties running a course of sum and sums of money but more, particularly any right title claim which the sd. David Osburn had to the estate of him the said Benjamin Osburn my father either real or personal forever and in consequence of receiving of fifty Dollars, good and lawful money of this State have sold all my right and title claim or demand of the above mentioned estate to Calvin Riggs his heirs and assigns forever. In witness whereof I the said David Osburn have hereunto set my hand and seal this sixth day of February 1812.
