This Deed made the 18th day of November 1823 between Aaron Osborn & Eleanor his wife of the one part and John Denham of the other said both of Clermont County & State of Ohio. Witnesseth that the said Aaron for and in consideration of the sum of forty dollars lawful money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said John the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released and quit claimed, unto the said John Denham his heirs & assigns. All the following described real estate situate in the town of Bethel, and County and State aforesaid to-wit Four In Lots in said town known and designated on the recorded plat of said town by their numbers one hundred and seventy one (171) one hundred & seventy two (172), one hundred and ninety nine (199) and two hundred 200. To have and to hold all & singular the aforesaid lots & premises hereby sold and conveyed or intended to be sold and conveyed with all and singular the appurtenances rights & privileges therunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining unto him the said John Denham his heirs & assigns forever. And the said Aaron Osborn for himself his heirs, executors & administrators hereby relinquishes, releases, abeins and quit claims unto the said John Denham his heirs and assigns all the Estate, right title, interest claim and demand of him the said Aaron & his heirs &c. and all persons claiming by from through or under them or any of them, unto him the said John, his heirs & assigns forever. In Testimony Whereof the said Aaron Osborn & Eleanor his wife (who hereby releases her rights of dower in the premises) have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year above written In presence of us.

This Deed made this twenty fourth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty six, between James Denham of the county of Lancaster and State of Pennsylvania of the first part, and John Denham of the County of Clermont and State of Ohio, of the first part, Witnesseth that the said James Denham for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and six dollars lawful money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said John Denham the receipt whereof is hereby
