Poles to the Beginning, containing one hundred and twenty two acres, 92. Poles. — And all the Estate right Title Interest claim, and Demand of him the said Aron Osborn in and to the above described, premises is hereby conveyed to the said William Winn To Have and to Hold the said Tract of Land with all and singular the Privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, unto the said Aron Osborn his heirs Executors &c.
