Van Fleet was at the September Term of the Court of Common Pleas in and for the County of Hamilton and State of Ohio appointed Guardian of Mيرانces Mastbrook & her Dames Mastbrook Henry Mastbrook Malona Mastbrook and Lois Mastbrook minor heirs of Chester Mastbrook deceased Now if the said Miles Van Fleet shall give bond with fidelity the Court repose in him in this behalf and shall under an accurate statement of his transactions with a just account of the profits arising and accruing from the personal & real Estate of his wards (they being the minor children of said deceased) and shall deliver up the same to the Court when thereunto required. Then this Allegation shall be void otherwise remains in full force
