Know all men by these presents that we Harris Post Lyman C. Hunt and William Ballentine do hereby hold and jointly bind unto the State of Ohio in the penal sum of One Thousand dollars to the payment of which we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators with our seal and dated this 4th day of June A.D. 1844.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Harris Post at a special session of the Court of Common Pleas of the County of Warren and State of Ohio began and held at the Court House at Norton in said County on the 1st day of June, A.D. 1844, was appointed Administrator of the Estate of James Post late of said County deceased.

Now if the said Harris Post shall within three months from this date return into said Court a true inventory of all the Goods, Chattels, rights, moneys and effects, and the proceeds of all the real Estate of said deceased that may be sold for the payment of his debts or legacies which shall at any time come to the knowledge or possession, of said Administrator or to the possession of any other person for him, and shall render upon oath a just and true account of his Administration within Eighteen months and at any other time when required by the Court, and shall pay over any Balance that shall be in his hands after the payment of the debts of said deceased to such person or persons as the Court shall appoint to receive the same then this obligation shall be void otherwise remain in full force and virtue in Law

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas a by the warrant from A.D. 1844 of the Court of Common Pleas of the County of Warren Ohio, the above bound Samuel Astor was appointed Guardian of Phebean of Astor aged five years and Corthy N. Astor aged 11 years and Susan Ruth Astor aged three years infant Children of said Samuel Astor

Now if the said Samuel Astor shall well and faithfully discharge all the duties incumbent upon him as such Guardian, and shall return an accurate statement of his transactions of such Guardian at such time as the Court shall require, and shall pay over all moneys that may come into
