This was the last will and testament of Abraham Osborn late of Warren County deceased was produced in open Court and proved by the oaths of Adam Syme & Christopher Lee Jr & approved by the Court & the Court ordered that said will & probate be recorded. The Executors in said will namelie Abraham Osborn Jr & William Osborn appear in Court and signify their acceptance of the trust of executing said will & are duly sworn as such Executors to give bond with surety in the penal sum of Eight thousand Dollars Adam Syme & Christopher Lee Jr are accepted as their surety. The Court appoints William A Shivers Joseph Stock & John Syme appraisers of personal property.

I Abraham Osborn Sr of the County of Warren and in the State of Ohio do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner & form following: That is to say first it is my will that

my funeral expences paid all my just debts be fully paid
Should it is my will that all my property real and personal
is to be sold at Publick sale by my said executor then I give and assign
to my only son Abraham Osborn Jr. the one half of all my property
then sold But my son Abraham Osborn is to pay to Joseph Bond
the full sum of fifty Dollars out of his half which I give and assign
to my three Daughters the other half of my property when sold to
be divided between my three Daughters equal share namely Mary
Kiepson and Polly Osborn & Elizabeth Osborn first and lastly
I have hereby constitute and appoint my son Abraham Osborn
and my son in law William Osborn to be the Executors for this my
last will and Testament executing and annulling all former wills
made by me made and ratifying and confirming this and no other
to be my last will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this the 24th day of Jan'y 1839
