 thousand eight hundred and thirty one, within and for said County, Present
 the Honorable Reuben Wood President, & Richard Hayes, Leicester King
 and Eli Waldwin his associates Judges holding said court

Thomas McCullough Deceased.

This day the last will and testament of Thomas McCullough late of Poland
 deceased, was produced in Court, and proved by the oaths of Aaron Seroggs
 and Andrew Dunlap, and approved by the Court. Thereupon George McCullough and
 Samuel McCullough the Executors named in said Will appeared in court and took the oath and
 that the Executors give Bonds with surety in the penal sum of five hundred dollars. Andrew
 Barger and Aaron Seroggs are accepted as his surety. Robert P. Justice, Andrew Dunlap and John
 Hunter are appointed appraisers on said Estate.
