Conrad. Hill Deceased

This day the last will and testament of Conrad. Hill late of Canfield deceased was produced in Court and proved by the oaths of Edward Hadsworth and Jacob Dinstman and approved by the Court where upon one of the Executors named in the Will to wit Henry Canon appeared in open Court and took the oath as executor ordered by the Court that he give Bonds with Surety in the penal Sum of four thousand Dollars The Court accept Peter Lynn and George Lynn as his Sureties and appoint Edward Hadsworth Jacob Dinstman and Herman Doud appraisers of personal Property

John Hill Deceased

This day John Mitchell Guardian to Cynthia Hill daughter of John Hill late of Canfield deceased Resigned his letter of Guardianship to said Cynthia and moved the Court that he be discharged, where upon it is considered by the Court that said motion be granted

Aaron Osborn Deceased

Ordered that Amos Osborn be appointed administrator on the Estate of Aaron Osborn late of Canfield deceased to give Bonds with Surety in the penal Sum of three hundred dollars John Pierrel and Joseph Jackson are accepted as his Sureties Robert Kerr Joshua Cotton and Abraham Meehan are appointed appraisers on said Estate

David Price Deceased

Ordered that Mary Price be appointed Administrator on the Estate of David Price late of Hubbard deceased to give bonds with Surety in the penal Sum of three hundred dollars Joel Smith and Archibald Price are accepted as her Sureties John Bredin Aaron Hillier and Abraham Tolson are appointed appraisers

Susannah Whitesell Insane

Ordered that Conrad & Osborn be appointed Guardian to take care of the person and property of Susannah Whitesell of Canfield an insane person until she be restored to the use of her person and to Rachael Whitesell Daughter of the said Susannah until she arrives to the age of twelve years to give Bonds with Surety in the penal Sum of one hundred dollars Abraham Kelly is accepted as his Surety

Susannah Whitesell Insane

This day the overseers of the poor for the township of Canfield produced an amount of \$52-86 3/4 for the care and maintainance of the said Susannah Whitesell and the same being accepted by the Court it is ordered by the Court that the amount be paid by the County

George McCarty Deceased

Further time until the next Term is allowed the Administrator on the estate of George McCarty deceased to make a final settlement of said estate
