Clerks office of the Court of Common Pleas of Suscarawas County Letters of
Administration on the Estate of Samuel Osburn Sr. as follows:

Suscarawas County } I know ye that the Court of Common Pleas of said
County hath duly granted Letters of Administration on
the Estate of Samuel Osburn Sr. deceased unto Samuel Osburn Jr. and
is committed the administration of all and singular the goods Chattels
monies rights and credits of said deceased, and also the proceeds of all
the Real Estate of said deceased which he may be authorized to sell,
and whose duty it shall be to administer the same and to adjust
and settle up the accounts of the Estate of said deceased in all res-
pects agreeably to Law: In testimony whereof the Seal of said Court
is here affixed this 28th day of August A.D. 1826
