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
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Memorandum Letters Testamentary were this day granted to Henry Severey Executor of Mary Blackly Dec. Inventory to be exhibited into the registers Office at Gettysburg on or before the 29<sup>th</sup> day of December next, & an account or reckoning on or before the 29<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D. 1835  
Witness my hand the 29<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D. 1834.

In the name of God Amen I Samuel Osburn of Straban Township in the County of Adams & State of Penn: being in Good health & of sound mind memory & understanding thanks be to God for the same, do make & publish this my last will & testament hereby revoking & making void all ~~the~~ former wills by me by me at any time heretofore made. And first I direct that my body be decently interred at the direction of my Executors and as to such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to bless me I dispose of the same as follows - I will & bequeath to my wife Margaret One thousand dollars to be paid her by my hereafter named Executors as soon as so much money is collected out of my estate (after the payment of my Just debts) also I devise to my said One Cowher Choice Bed & Bedding & furniture her Choice; also a Case of drawers & the Family Bible; also all the Cloths Linen that may be in the house at my decease. - I will & bequeath to my four daughters Two thousand dollars to be divided among them equally, that is, I devise to my daughter Margaret intermarried with Abel Beach five hundred Dollars: also I devise to my daughter Anna intermarried with Ralph Fikes five hundred dollars: also I devise to my daughter Mary intermarried with William Vanosdalen five hundred dollars: also I devise to my daughter Magdalena five hundred dollars & in addition on to the said five hundred dollars devised to my daughter Magdalena I direct that she get one Cowher Choice after that of my wife & an Outfit equal to that of my other three daughters. The above devised two thousand dollars is to be paid, paid by my Executors One thousand thereof within one year after my decease, and the other moiety thereof within two years after my decease the above said sum as paid over is to be distributed equally among my four daughters. - I will & bequeath to my son Levi Osburn all the balance residue & remainder of my estate Real Personal & mixed of what soever kind or nature that I may be seized & possessed at the time of my decease. And I do hereby make & ordain my son Levi & William Vanosdalen Executors of this my last will & Testament - In Witness whereof I Samuel Osburn the testator, have to this my last will & testament set my hand & seal this twenty first day of March in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred & thirty four.
