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**Last Will and Testament**

**OF**

Jane Osborn

**DECEASED**

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6th. Ad. 1849

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In the name of God Amen, I Jane Osborn, of Patton  
Township in the county of Allegheny, & state of Pennsylvania  
Being weak in body, but of sound mind, memory and  
Understanding, Praised be God for the same, do make  
this, my last will & Testament in manner & form follow-  
=ing

I give, devise & bequeath, unto my Beloved Husband  
Rev Joseph, Osborn, All my property, Real, Personal  
and mixed, of what nature or kind soever, & where so-  
=ever the same shall be at the time of my Death.

I in trust, for the benefit of himself, & my three chil-  
=dren (John, Frances, & the babe,) During his natural  
lifetime, to be managed by him as he may think best,  
for the advantage of himself & the children aforesaid.

And at his death, My will is, that my whole Estate  
as aforesaid, or so much of it as shall remain unexpen-  
=ed

Be equally divided between my three children as afore-  
=named, should they survive him, And in case of the  
Death of any of them, leaving no issue, my will is that  
it be given, to the survivors or the survivor of them.

And I do hereby, nominate, constitute, and appoint my  
said Husband, Sole Executor of this, my last will and  
Testament, And I do hereby, empower him to sell, and  
convey <sup>my</sup> real Estate or any part of it, that he may think  
proper, for the benefit & advantage of my children
