IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN, I James Osborn of New Sewickly Township Beaver County State of Pennsylvania being weak in body but of sound and perfect mind and memory blessed be Almighty God for the same I do make and publish this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say first I give and bequeath unto my son William the sum of One Dollar. I also give and bequeath unto my son Joseph the sum of One Dollar also to my son James the sum of One Dollar also to my son John the sum of One Dollar also to my son Samuel the sum of fifty dollars which he has now in hands by notes on my son Robert which money I paid for him the first payment of fifty dollars of Sam which was bought from Abraham honor that sum I allow my son Robert to pay Samuel and to all my daughters namely Margaret Martha to each one of them the sum of One Dollar each and to my son Robert I do give and bequeth all the residue of my property goods and chattels all notes, bonds mortgages rights or credits whatsoever or other ways can be I give and bequeath the same to my <sup>son</sup> Robert whom I hereby appoint the sole executor of this my last will and testament hereby revoking all former wills by me made.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF have hereunto set my hand and seal the tenth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty one.
