Bond 16 Administration of the Estate of Frederick Bodine late of Perry Township Deceased  
 Be it Remembered that on the 4<sup>th</sup> Day of May AD 1836 Letters of Administration in due and common form of Law were granted by Alex Best Register for the Probate of Wills and granting Letters of Administration in and for the County of Columbia to Isaac Singer Administrator of all and singular the goods & chattels rights and credits which were of Frederick Bodine at the time of his decease the widow having Renounced in the words following Danville May the 4<sup>th</sup> 1836 To the Register of Columbia County  
 In this is to inform you that I decline to act as Administrator to the Estate of my late husband Frederick Bodine late of Perry Township deceased and pray that Letters of Administration may be granted to my friend Isaac Singer. yours &c Christiana <sup>her</sup> ~~mother~~ <sup>Bodine</sup>  
 Attest Isaac Salomon the said Administrator having first induredes Jacob Wagner and Philip Seidel in the sum of six hundred dollars and being duly sworn to administer said Estate according to law and faithfully to comply with the laws of this Commonwealth relating to collateral inheritances

The Last Will and testament of William Osman late of Cottawissa Township Columbia County and State of Pennsylvania Concerning the shortness and uncertainty of this mortal life and being in health and having the proper use of my understanding (thanks be unto Almighty God for this) do of my own free will dispose of my property in manner following First I do bequeath unto my son Peter Osman Five hundred Dollars out of the price of the farm that he purchased of me Secondly I do bequeath unto my son William Osman five hundred Dollars out of the price of the farm that he purchased of me Thirdly I bequeath unto my two Daughters Sarah and Hannah Osman and Giba Osman my grandson the farm with the appurtenances on which I now reside and if they cannot agree to live together then the property shall be sold and each of them shall have five hundred dollars to be equal with the others of my children and farther I bequeath unto my two daughters Sarah & Hannah my carriage and harness and one horse and each of them one cow and six sheep and Giba my grandson three Sheep Fourthly I bequeath unto my daughter Catharine Vestine five hundred Dollars (to be paid out of the balance of the price of the two farms that I sold) after my decease Fifthly I bequeath unto the heirs of my son John Osman deceased the farm lying on the Little Roaring Creek one part lying in Rush Township North County and another in Cottawissa Township Columbia County with the appurtenances which shall be their whole share of my Estate Finally my Will is that after my decease all my personal property be disposed of by my executors or Administrators the proceeds of which with all money either outstanding or in my possession (after my debts and all reasonable expenses are paid) be equally divided amongst my heirs Viz

Be it remembered that on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of May 1836 before me Frederick Frick Deputy Register for the Probate of wills and granting Letters of Administration in and for said County was produced and approved the last will and Testament of William Cramer late of Cottawipca Township deceased and Letters Testamentary were granted to Ezra S. Hayhurst Administrator therein named who being duly approved to administer said estate according to law and in presence of special witnesses and a Justice of the Peace in Frick on

Peter Cramer William Cramer Sarah Cramer Hannah Cramer Ziba Cramer my grand son and Catharine Vestine my lawful heirs it will be observed that all the property that may be found in the two rooms in the west end of my house in the second story my Executor nor any other person or persons shall have authority to meddle with as it is the property of my two daughters Sarah & Hannah Cramer independent of my estate on witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty four Wm Cramer seal

Ellis First Coeciel I William Cramer the testator herein before named do make and publish this addition to my will as part thereof to all intents and purposes viz I nominate and appoint my friend Ezra S. Hayhurst to be the Executor of this my will with power to sell my farm herein bequeathed to my daughters and Ziba Cramer if they cannot agree to live together and make a sufficient title for the same Witness my hand & seal February seventeenth A.D. 1835 Wm Cramer seal Witness at signing of this coeciel Feb 17<sup>th</sup> 1835 William C.  Second coeciel Whereas I William Cramer of the Township of Cottawipca County of Columbia and State of Pennsylvania have made my last will and testament in writing bearing date & now I do by this my writing which I hereby declare to be a coeciel to my said will to be taken as a part thereof give and bequeath to my two daughters Sarah and Hannah Cramer two of the best of my hogs my corner cupboard my ten plated stove that stands in my kitchen and my large looking glass that hangs in my room and I do give and bequeath to my grand son Ziba Cramer my Plough Harrow sled and two sets of horse gears and lastly it is my desire that this my presents coeciel be annexed to and made a part of my last will and testament to all intents and purposes on witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this second day of March one thousand eight hundred and thirty six Wm Cramer seal Signed sealed published and declared by the above named William Cramer as a coeciel to be annexed to the said last will and testament in the presence of Wm Cader Hannah Cader Columbia County Pa. Be it remembered that on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of May 1836 before me Frederick Frick Deputy Register for the Probate of wills and granting Letters of Administration for said County came William Cader & William C. Ellis the subscribing witnesses to the preceding will and also witnesses to the first and second coeciels to said will of William Cramer late of Cottawipca Township in Columbia County deceased who being duly approved do depose and say that they were present and heard the above named William Cramer the testator sign seal publish pronounce and on the foregoing instrument and the first and second coeciel thereto as and for his last will and Testament and at the time of so doing the said testator was of sound & disposing mind memory & understanding to the best of these deponents observation knowledge and belief that they signed the same in his presence at his request said will in the presence of each other and that Thomas William Cader and William C. Ellis one of these deponents have written both the said will and coeciels & subscribed by them as witnesses and to the first & second coeciels one of the said witnesses names are signed to each Wm Cader William C.
