

Description: Deed, Abraham Osburn of Menallen Twp, Fayette Co., PA to Richard Osburn
of the same place

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This Indenture made the twenty first day of January in the year of our Lord 1807
 hundred and seven between Abraham Robinson of the County of Allegheny
 the County of Westmoreland and State of Pennsylvania and Jane his wife of the one part and Thomas & Atkinson of the County of Fayette
 in the State aforesaid of the other part. Whereas Abraham Robinson hath bargained sold conveyed and sell with and shall
 with the said Thomas & Atkinson for the consideration of Eighty dollars to him paid the
 weight of the said Robinson to be fully paid his grant full & convey all his right &
 title to the said Estate of another Robinson deceased being three sixth part of one hundred
 & sixty three Acres of land situate in the Township of Millersburg & County aforesaid
 as the same more fully. As Witness my hand and seal the day & year above written

This Indenture made the nineteenth day of September in the year of our Lord
 hundred and seven between John Wells of the County of Westmoreland and State of
 Pennsylvania and Jane his wife of the one part and Thomas & Atkinson of the County of Fayette
 in the State aforesaid of the other part. Whereas Benjamin Mackay and
 Jane his wife and by sundry confirmations and assurances in the law duly had made and were
 lawfully seized of their dominion of Tract of land situate being in
 the County of Westmoreland containing two hundred and eighty two Acs
 and one quarter and allurance of Six Acres of land for tracks &c and being so lawfully seized as
 aforesaid by their Indenture bearing date on the 12th day of June 1799 for the considera-
 tion therein mentioned did grant bargain and sell with the said John Wells freely to these presents
 to his heirs and assigns forever all that the above described Tract of land and premises as in and by said
 Indenture duly authenticated and Recorded in the office for Recording of deeds well for said County
 situate in the County of Westmoreland may more fully and largely appear. Now this Indenture sheweth that
 the said John Wells and the said Jane his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand
 seven hundred and fifty dollars to him the said John Wells well and truly in hand paid by
 the said Thomas & Atkinson stand before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt &
 payment whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have granted bargained sold conveyed and sell
 with the said Thomas & Atkinson his heirs and assigns all the above described Tract of land
 and premises together with all & singular the buildings and improvements thereon erected and
 made and all ways & Waters & watercourses and writings hereditaments and premises with their appurtenances
 whatsoever & accounts belonging in any wise appertaining and all the Estate right title interest
