The Petition of John Osborne Elder son of Richard Osborne late of Warrington Township in the said County deceased in behalf of himself his Sisters & Brother Mary Ann & Jonathan Osborne was read & setting forth that the Petitioner and his Sisters and Brother are entitled to a considerable Estate under their late Father Richard Osborne that on account of their minority they are incapable of taking the management of it upon themselves & there is no Person legally authorized to manage it for them That the Petitioner being twenty years of Age Praying the Court will permit him to choose a Guardian for himself & appoint Guardians to his Sisters Mary Ann & his Brother Jonathan all of whom being under the Age of fourteen years are incapable of Choosing for themselves & Rule that the said John Osborne do appear & choose a Guardian And the said John Osborne at the same time appearing in open Court chose Benj. Dismant & Benj. Tyson of the said County Yeoman to be his Guardians who were by the Court appointed And the Court at the same time appointed the said Benj. Dismant & Benj. Tyson Guardians to the said Infants Mary Ann & Jonathan Osborne
