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the Testator by this my bodicil to my last Will & Testament do Revoke the devise made to
Semina Welsh so far only as Relates to my undivided half part of a Lot of Land on poplar
lane containing one Acre And I do hereby give & devise my said undivided half part of the
said Lot of Land on poplar lane which half part containing one Acre with the Appurte-
nances unto my Niece Elizabeth Thomas her Heirs & Assigns for ever And I confirm my
last Will & Testament in all its parts except only so far as the same is hereby altered
and I desire this bodicil may be deemed part of my last Will & Testament Witness my
Hand and seal this twenty third day of the fourth month called April One thousand
eight hundred and four. Wm Wishart Esq^r Witnesses present Thomas Wishart

10.47. This is the last Will and Testament of me Charles Osborne of Scarborough in
in the County of York Esquire whereby I dispose of my Effects, as follows first I
give and bequeath unto my Mother Elizabeth Osborne for and during the Term of
her natural life One Annuity or clear Annual sum of One hundred Pounds to be
paid by my Executor herein after named by four equal quarterly payments in
every year the first payment thereof to begin and be made at the end of three Months
next after my decease And I order and direct my said Executor to put or place out
in some of the publick funds such a sum of Money as will produce or bring in
the annual Interest of One hundred Pounds wherewith to satisfy & pay the said
Annuity and from and after the decease of my said Mother then I give the said
sum of Money so to be put or placed out as aforesaid unto my particular friends
Phineas Bond Esquire of the Middle Temple London, his Executors Administrators
and Assigns for ever Subject nevertheless to and I do hereby charge the same with the
payment thereof of the following Legacies or sums of Money that is to say To my
friend M^{rs} Williamina Bond the sum of One hundred Pounds To my God Daughter
Frances Bond the like sum of One hundred Pounds and to each of M^{rs} Bonds other
Daughters (viz^t) Williamina Rebecca and Elizabeth the sum of fifty Pounds a piece
Item I give to my said Mother Elizabeth Osborne a Legacy of One hundred Pounds to be
paid by my Executor within six Months next after my decease Item I give to M^{rs}
Mary Armstrong the Widow of my late Uncle M^r William Armstrong deceased a
Legacy of two hundred Pounds and I order the same to be paid by my Executor
within twelve Months next after my decease And as to all the Rest residue and
Remainder of my Goods and Chattels ready Monies & Securities for Money of every kind
Personal Estate and Personal Effects whatsoever and wheresoever of what nature kind
or quality soever the same doth or may consist I give & bequeath the same Subject
to the payment thereof of my Just debts and funeral expences unto the said Phineas
Bond his Executors Administrators and Assigns for ever - And lastly I do hereby
nominate constitute and appoint him the said Phineas Bond sole Executor of this
my last Will and Testament and do Revoke and make void all former & other Wills
and use at any time heretofore made and executed In Witness whereof I have to
last Will and Testament (and to a Duplicate hereof) set my Hand & Seal
