In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal at Philadelphia this fourteenth day of May in the year of our Lord 1830.

I Robert C. Arthur of West Philadelphia in the Township of Blockley in the County of Philadelphia and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Storekeeper, Being of a sound mind and understanding do make and publish this my last will and Testament in the manner following that is to say.

First I do by this my will appoint Joseph Hannis Gun Smith of the Northern Liberties in the County of Philadelphia and in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to be my Executor of this my will. And it is my wish and desire that immediately after my decease that the above named Joseph Hannis take possession of my property of every kind and that he proceed as fast as possible to settle up the Estate I would wish all my property regularly and fairly exposed to public sale in the most advantageous manner. But no unfair means resorted to whatever as I wish every person to get the worth of his or her money.

Secondly I wish the proceeds of said sale together with whatever money I may have on expenses and after they are all settled then I wish all my other debts paid as fast as the funds come in so that the nett ballance may appear after all is settled up I will mention the claimings against my estate which will never be asked for by my claimants though it is my intention that they shall be paid as well as others provided my estate will extend so far as to reach them after all others are paid off first to John Kimmings and Leo the sum of Two hundred and two Dollars bearing interest at six per cent from the first day of January one thousand eight hundred and ten. 1810. ~~1797~~
