In the Name of God Amen the Eighteenth Day of March in the Year of our Lord God one Thousand seven Hund: & fifty-one I Thomas Osburn of Mount Pleasant Township in the County of York & Province of Pennsylvania being sick and Weak in Body but of good & perfect Memory thanks unto God therefore Do make & Ordain this my last Will and Testament In manner & Form following first of all I Recommend my Soule into the hands of Almighty God that gave it & my Body I Comitt to the Earth to be Buried in a Decent way at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter Named and as touching my worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to Bless my Endeavours I Will that all my Just Debts and funeraall Expences shall be paid And further I give and bequeath unto my Dear and Loving Mother Francis Osburn a good sufficient Maintainance out of the Benefices that hath been pleased God to Endow me with all and to be given and paid yearly in good order by my Executors further I give and bequeath unto my Loving Brother Noble Osburn one Horse that I bought of the S^r Noble Osburn further I give and bequeath to my Loving Sister Margaret Osburn one Bay Mare and Colt. further I give and bequeath to my Loving Sister Mary Osburn one Black Mare and Colt. All the Rest and residue of my Estate both Real and Personal, I give into the Hands of my Executors to be disposed to Sale in the best manner that may be, and after the Decease of my Mother Francis Osburn If any part or sum of Money should be remaining of the maintainance of my Mother I Will that the said Money if any may be Divided proportionably in three parts the third part to my Sister Margaret and another third to my Sister Mary and a third to my Brother Nobles Eldest Son James Osburn to the which I doe appoint Thomas Weavry and Noble Osburn full and sole Executors of this my Last Will and testament. Lastly I do hereby revoke Disannul and make void all former Wills and Legacies by me in anywise heretofore made and bequeathed either by Word or by Writing ratifying and confirming this to be my Last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal, the day and year above Written

Beit Remembered That on the 2 day of May 1751 the last Will & Testament of Thomas Ozburn dec. was proved in due form of Law and Probate and Letters Testamentary were granted to Thomas McCartney and Noble Ozburn Executors in the said Testament named being first duly qualified thereto well & truly to Administer the said Decedents Estate and to bring in an Inventory thereof into the Regist. Office at York at or before the 2. Day of June next and render a true Account when thereunto Lawfully required

In the Name of God Amen I Moses Mappin of the Township of Waranton and County of York and Province of Pennsylvania being Sick and weak in body but of perfect minde and memory and understanding thanks be to God therefor and calling to minde the Mortality of my body and that it is appointed for all men once to die I do constitute order and appoint this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say first all I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ, and I do appoint my body to be buried in a decent and Christian manner according to the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named. Imprimis I Will that all my Funerall Expences be fully satisfied Contented and paid, and also, all my other Just Debts whatsoever, to be fully discharged and paid in due time, Item I will and appoint that after my Decease all my Estate both Reall and personall be sold at handue by my Executors, I give unto my true and well beloved Wife ^{Mary} the third part of all the Money arising from the Sale of my Estate after the payment of all my just Debts. I also give unto my Wife Mary seven Acres of Land on the North branch that comes down from Jettor Mappes on the line for her use during her Widowhood and after to return to the purchaser. - and also that my Executors allow her five pounds to build her a house over and above her thirds. Item I give unto my Daughter Hannah ^{ten Shillings} as her full share of my Estate, I also order that the Mears belonging to Hannah be sold at the value and the money to be paid to my Executors and they to pay it to her when she comes to age I also give unto my two Daughters Mary and Elizabeth twenty pounds apiece and the money to be put to Interest till they come to age, I also order the the remaining part of my Estate to be Equally Divided amongst my three Sons and if it shall hapen that any of them shall die before they come to age that his share be Divided amongst the Survivers that is the boys and the girls after the same manner, I also order that my Sons be bound out to trade, such as they like best with the Consent of my Executors Now finally I order and appoint my trusty and well beloved friends Thomas Cox and Henry Clark my whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testament to be duly and truly Executed in every part thereof and do make void all former Wills by me made and declare this only to be my last Will and Testament and In Witness thereof I have set my hand and seal this ninth Day of July in the Year one thousand seven hundred and fifty one
