In the name of God Amen I Hannah Stockly of Accomack County being in perfect mind & memory knowing not how soon I may depart this Life have thought fit to make this my last Last Will and Testament for to Dispose of my Estate in manner and form as followeth
Imprimis I give & bequeath unto my Grandson Thomas Stockly my Mare & Colt plow and harrow one bed & bolster and one sheet and two blankets and a rug and bedsted & all my Logs and my best Chest & a case of bottles and three cows and 1 Steer about six years old and one iron pot and hooks about six Gallons and one frying pan and one earthen Jug holding about three gallons and one Large pewter Dish and one pewter plate and four Sheep
Item I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Semimah Stockly ten head of Cattle & my best feather bed & bolster & 1 Green Rug & two blankets one sheet & one pillow & one new pewter Basin & one pewter Tankard & one plate & one Salt Seller and half a Dozen of Spoons
Item I give & bequeath unto my Grandson William Stockly four Sheep & one iron pot holding about three Gallons & pot hooks & one plough
Item I give & bequeath unto my Grandson John Stockly
