Esa. Osborne

In the Name of God Amen The Seventh Day April  
in the year of Our Lord one thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety four  
I Elizabeth Osborne of the County of Amelia being of a sound  
Disposing Mind and Memory, yet considering the Uncertainty of  
this mortal Life, (do think it proper to make and ordain this  
my last Will and Testament which is as followeth, vizt in the first  
Place my will and Desire is that All my just Debts be paid, -  
Item I give and bequeath to my Good Son Edward Scott  
one Negro Man Named Sam, who he has in his possession, also  
one Hundred Pounds Current Money of Virginia to him and his  
Heirs for Ever -

Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter Agnes  
Branch Scott, one Negro Girl Named Dilsey with all  
her futer Increase to her and her Heirs for Ever

Item I give and bequeath to my Grand Daughter,  
Elizabeth Archer Scott one Negro, Named Charity to her  
and her Heirs for Ever

Item I give <sup>and bequeath</sup> to my Grand Sons, named as followeth  
to wit Thomas Scott, William Scott, Samuel Scott, &  
James Scott Each of them

fifty Pounds Current Money of Virginia to be paid  
to them as they Come of Age to them and their Heirs  
for Ever

Item I give and bequeath to my Son Branch Osborne  
one Negro, Wench Named Hannah and her futer increase  
and all the Rest & Residue of my Estate of Every kind  
whatsoever to him and his Heirs forever -

It is my further Will and Desire that my Estate may  
not be Inven-tor'd or Apprais'd  
Lastly I Constituted and Appointed my Son Branch Osborne  
Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby  
Revoaking all former Wills by me made In Witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Affixed my  
Seal the Day and year aforesaid Written -  
Signed Sealed Published and Declared by the said  
Elizabeth Osborne for his last Will and Testament  
In the Presence of Us

At a Court held for Amelia the 27<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1794 this will was exhibited into Court and proved by the Oaths of Archer Jones and William Walker two of the witnesses thereto subscribed sworn to by Branch Osborne the Executor therein named and was ordered to be Recorded and on the motion of the said Executor who with Honor Osborne his security acknowledged bond in the penalty of £2000 as the Law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate in due form Truly Recorded
