Bond of his adm^r

Know All Men, by these presents, that we Mary M^r Osborne
and Senias Bap are held and firmly bound unto the
Commonwealth of Virginia, in the sum of Four thousand
dollars; to the payment whereof well and truly to be made
to the said Commonwealth we bind ourselves and each
of us, our and each of our heirs, executor and administrators
jointly and severally firmly by these presents: Sealed with
our seals and dated this 8th day of Sept^r A^d one thou-
sand eight hundred and forty five, and in the 40th year
of the Commonwealth.

The condition of this obligation is, That if the said Mary
M^r Osborne, administrator of the goods, chattels and credits
of Daniel Osborne deceased, do make a true and perfect
inventory of all and singular the goods, chattels and credits
of the said deceased which have or shall come to the hands
possession or knowledge of her, ^{the said} Mary M^r Osborne or into the hands
or possession of any other person or persons for her and the
same so made, exhibited into the County court of Chesterfield
county, when she shall be thereto required by the said court;
and such goods, chattels and credits to well and truly admin-
ister according to law, and further do make a just and true
account of her doings and doings therein when thereto required
by the said court; and all the rest of the said goods, chattels
and credits which shall be found remaining upon the ac-
count of the said administrator, the same being first exam-
ined and allowed by the justices of the said court for
the time being, shall deliver and pay unto each person
respectively, as are entitled to the same by law; and if it
shall hereafter appear that any last will and testament
was made by the deceased, and the same be proved in
court, and the executor obtain a certificate of probat thereof,
and the said Mary M^r Osbornes do in such case being requir-
ed, renue and deliver up her letters of administration, then
this obligation to be void, else to remain in full force
