Francis Friend of Chesterfield county do make and ordain this
my last will & Testament in manner and form following for
recommending my Immortal soul to God that gave it and my
Body to the earth to be buried at the discretion of my executor
and my worldly estate I dispose of as followeth;

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Judith Friend three
the choice of my negroes at my Death and set of teaspoons and
cups and saucers and all the cash that I shall leave at my death
and five table spoons and the trunks and my black mare
to her and her heirs forever.

Item I give to my son Edward Friend and to my son Joseph
Friend, and to my son Nathaniel Friend, and to my Daughter
Ann Osborne, and to my Daughter Francis Osborne, and to my
Daughter Fidelth Friend, all the rest of my estate to be
Equally divided between them and their heirs forever after
my just debts and funeral expences is paid and I hereby
appoint my son Edward Friend and my son Nathaniel Friend

to be my executors of this my last will and Testament and
my desire is that my estate be not appraised hereby revoking
all other wills or wills herebefore made by me and In Witness
whereof I have set my hand and affixed my seal this 15
day of June anno. domini. 1772.
