Item I give to my son Mark Moore all the remainder part of my Estate holdable
to him & his Heirs & Assigns forever

As also I leave my son Mark Moore Executor of this my last Will & Testament
I do hereby utterly disannull, revoke & every other former Will, Testament, Acquies made by
me in any wise before this time named, willed & bequeathed ratifying & confirming
& no other to be my last Will & Testament I Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
& fixed my seal the Day & year above written

I now give devise & bequeath unto my Daughter Lucy Peterson & to her Heirs & Assigns forever
the following Negroes named Maddy, Jacke, Dob, Suckey, Jane, Will, Helen, they being the
Negroes I purchased of Peter Petersons Estate, Joe, Matt, Little, Joe, Samuey, Kitt, Mogs, Daniel,
Frank, Britly, Jane, Will, Jeffery, Betty, Lilly, Bilsby, Rochester, John, old Jane, old Dick

I now give & bequeath unto my Daughter Agnes Goode & to her Heirs & Assigns forever
the following Negroes named Dick, Hamblin, Sarah, Charles, Yott, Usey, Robin, Gato, Geo
Nancy, Adam, Sarah, Bilsby, Geo, Nancy, John, Betty, old Simon

I now give devise & bequeath unto my Daughter Betty, Eppes Branch & to her Heirs & Assigns
forever the following Negroes named Hannah, Nancy, Kiler, Shebe, Billey, Milen, Yott, Salt
give the use of the following Negroes, So, Will, Nancy, Vell, Sambo, Jabb, Betty, Subo, Ago,
Sarah & Polley to my said Daughter Betty, Eppes Branch during her natural Life & at her
death to be equally divided amongst her children if any when they come of Age or married
to hold to such children respectively & their Heirs forever. But in case my said Daughter
should leave no Child: Then the said Negroes & their increase to be equally divided between
my son, Edward Osborne & my Daughter, Lucy Peterson & Agnes Goode to them & their
Heirs forever

I now give devise & bequeath unto my grand Daughter Elizabeth ^{Peterson} one Negroe Girl
named Nancy to her & her Heirs forever

I now give devise & bequeath unto my grand Son Thomas Goode & to his Heirs &
& Assigns forever one Negroe Boy named Casar

Item I give devise & bequeath unto my Daughter Lucy Pitson all Debt
& accounts that she is owing of me or shall be at my Death


I desire that my Estate should not be appraised

And lastly do nominate constitute & appoint my said Son
Edward Osborne Exor. of this my last Will & Testament & Witnesses where-
of I the said Edward Osborne have hereunto set my hand & affixed my Seal
this twenty first Day of April one thousand seven hundred & eighty one
