Memory calling to mind the uncertainty of this Life doth hereby declare
my last Will & Testament to this

I give & bequeath to Mary Watkins Daughter of William Watkins of the County
of Lincolne six hundred Pounds a new & good ^{single} Hair & two good Honors to her
& her Heirs forever

I give & bequeath to Benjamin Branch Junr one stud House named
Fearnought to him & to his Heirs forever.

I give & bequeath to my god Son John Croker Son of John Croker one Regent
named Phillis to him & his Heirs forever.

I give & bequeath to James Thwait one small stud House named Abornoy to
to his Heirs forever

All the Residue of my Estate including Lands Slaves & every other kind
of Property whatsoever after paying my Just Debts & funeral Expences
I give to be equally divided between my three Sisters Vizt. Lucy Sturton
Goode & Betty Cooper Branch To hold to them & their Heirs forever

Lastly I do nominate & appoint James Thwait & Benjamin Branch Junr. Executors
of this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & seal this seventh Day of March 1783
