Impresing I desire that my Body be buried in a quiet Manner by my Friends and Executors hereafter named

Item I give devise and bequeath my Land and Tiths that lyes in the Town of Galeswille in this County to my three grand Daughters Anne Osborne Elizabeth Archer and Northampton Waltham to them and their respective Heirs forever and for the said Tiths to be paid by them my said three grand Daughters as Tenants in common and not as joint Tenants

Item I give devise and bequeath all the Remuneration and Residue of my Estate of every kind and Denomination whatsoever both real and personal to my son Orchard Waltham and his Heirs and Assigns forever and I desire that my Estate be not affected and doth hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said son Orchard Waltham my whole and sole Executor of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I the said William Waltham hath hereunto set my Hand and affixed my Seal this eighth Day of December one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight
