and Executrix of this my last will and Testament In witness whereof
I have here unto set my hand and affixed my seal this eight day of
September. 1796

In the name of god Amen I Francis Osborne of the County of
Chesterfield State of Virginia being at this time in a low state of health
but of perfect and sound mind and memory do make and ordain this my
last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say
I give and bequeath my whole Estate as well the Estate lately devised
to me by my deceased daughter Ann Osborne, as all other my
Estate of every kind whatsoever to my Sons Francis Osborne &
Thomas Osborne to be equally divided between them to them and
their respective heirs forever but in case of the death of either of

my said sons without Issue lawfully begotten of his body my will then
 is that the surviving son shall inherit the Estate hereby devised to
 both and should both my said sons die leaving no Issue then and
 in that case I give my said estate unto my Grandson Thomas
 Osborne Taylor and my Brother Edward Friend to be equally divided
 between them to them and their Heirs forever but in case my said
 Grandson should die before he arrives to the age of Twentyone
 years then I give the Estate hereby devised to him unto my said
 Brother to him and his Heirs forever. Lastly I do hereby nomi-
 nate constitute and appoint my said sons Francis and Thomas
 Osborne Executors of this my last will and testament hereby revoking
 all other and former wills by me made and declare this to be my
 last. In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand affixed
 my seal this twenty fifth day of February Anno Domini one
 thousand seven hundred and ninety three.
