The account of William Woodson rec. of Mary Ann Sheets decd. on the opposite side shows the amount due by him to each legatee, not including commissions. if the court should think the rec. ought to be allowed commissions the ^{rec.} ~~rec.~~ Woodson will be due Sally Bagby \$346.31 and to each of the other legatees, to wit, Fleming Bagby, William Bagby, Jesse Bagby and Mary Bagby each the sum of \$86.82 with interest from January 1822. all of which is respectfully submitted.

Comd fee \$20.00 ch to the executors.

At a court held for Cumberland county the 26th day of November 1832. The Commissioners heretofore appointed in this cause, this day made their report which is ordered to lie until the next court for exceptions. And at a court held for said county the 24th day of December 1832. The report of the Commissioners is returned and ordered to be received & the commissions therein mentioned by account of parties are allowed to the Executor William Woodson.

S. Osborn } In the name of God amen I Sally Osborn of the county of
Will } Loudoun & State of Virginia being of sound mind but weak in
body do make this my last will & Testament reciting all others of
any kind to exist. First my will and desire is that my Executor
hereafter named collect the amt. of Joseph Jenkins bond which
he owes me & out of it pay my just debts the bond allotted is one
hundred & twenty three dollars 33 cents after paying my just debts
my will and desire is that my uncle Chesley Anderson have
that tract or parcel of Land which I got from my grand
father whole supposed to be eight or nine acres be the same more
or less this I give in consideration of the trouble & expense which
he my uncle Chesley Anderson & his family have been at dur-
ing my sickness. If there is any money left out of the bond
allotted to after paying my just debts my will and desire is that
my Executor pay it over with my clothing &c to my uncle Chesley
Anderson for the entire benefit of his my uncle Chesley An-
dersons daughter Ellington to hold for her until she becomes
of lawful age or marries my will & desire is that Dr Robert
Thompson do act as my Executor & that he now hold Joseph
Jenkins bond to me for one hundred and twenty three

dollars & 33 cts during my life. Given under my hands & seals this
21st day of July 1831.

At a court held for Cumberland county the 25th day of February
1833. This last will and testament of Shally Osborne deceased was
presented in court and proved by the oaths of Thomas Bradley
and Lawrence Anderson two witnesses thereto and ordered to be recor-
ded & Robert Henderson relinquished his rights to qualify as
Executor. And at a court continued and held for said county
the 26th day of February 1833. on the motion of Shally Anderson
who with Thomas Bradley and Lawrence Anderson his securities
entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of
two hundred dollars conditioned according to law, and took the
oath required by law administration with the will annexed there-
of in due form is granted him.
