umberelle; and lastly as to all the rest residue  
and remainder of my personal Estate goods and  
Chattles of what kind and nature I give  
and bequeath the same to my said beloved Sister  
Nancy Osborn I also give and bequeath all my  
title of lands held by us in partnership in the  
County and State above witen with all the  
Appertinances thereunto belonging to hold to  
~~the said Nancy Osborn her Heirs and~~  
assigns for ever and the said Nancy Osborn  
my Sister I hereby appoint Sole executrix  
of this my last will and testament hereby  
revoking all former wills by me made in witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal  
this fourth day of May in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight

above named Jane Osborn to be her last  
will and testament in the presence of
