Private Justice

In the name of God Amen I Jane  
Osborn Spinster of Vermilion County and  
State of Illinois being weak in body but  
of sound and perfect mind and mem-  
ory bless'd be almighty God for the same  
do make and publish this my last will  
and testament in manner and form following  
that is to say. first I give and bequeath unto  
my Niece Betinda Greener my saddle  
and a Notted Counterspin. I do also give  
and bequeath unto my Niece Jane Osborn  
a Corolla Mat to one previously given  
to Betinda Greener also a flowered Count  
erspin and my umbrella. and lastly  
as to all the rest, residue, and reman'der of  
my personal estate goods and Chattels of  
what kind and Nature soever I give  
and bequeath the same to my <sup>sole</sup> beloved sister  
Nancy Osborn I also give and bequeath all  
my title of lands held by us in partnership  
in the County and State above written with  
all the Appurtenances thereunto belonging  
to hold to her the said Nancy Osborn her heirs  
and assigns forever and the said Nancy Osborn  
my sister Phibby appoint sole executrix  
of this my last will and testament hereby  
revoking all former wills by me made in wit-  
ness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and  
seal this fourth day of May in the year of our  
Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty  
eight Sign'd Sealed published and  
attested Afore said by the above named Jane  
Osborn to be her last will and Testament  
in the presence of us who have hereunto  
subscribed our names as witnesses in the pre-
