# Mary Mariah Osborn's Will

I Mary Mariah Osborn of the town of Plainfield in the County of Henricks and State of Indiana, being of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding do make publish and declare this to be my last will and testament

My will's first, That my funeral expenses and all my just debts shall be paid by my executor hereafter named

I give and bequeath to Isaac Hip son of Sebastian Hip and grand son of my deceased husband Isaac Osborn my fancy bureau with the looking glass attached my arm'd chairs, my stand table and all the carpet in the front room of the house in which I now reside

I give and bequeath to Emma Mariah Hip daughter of Sebastian Hip and grand daughter of my <sup>deceased</sup> husband Isaac Osborn, all of my queensware which was given to me by my late husband aforesaid

I give and bequeath to my sister Emily Christiana Manning my trundle bedstead and the bed and bedding belonging thereto, my wash bowl, my traveling trunk, my cooking stove with all the vessels belonging thereto, my straw bonnet, my pale blue striped flannel dress and my black silk dress

I give and bequeath to my sister Lency Highs Smith my brown luster dress and five dollars in money

I give and bequeath to my sister Sicily Ellen St John in California my pale blue plaid silk dress and ten dollars in money

I give and bequeath to my sister Anna Melissa Scott my muslin dress and five dollars in money

I give and bequeath to my brother Samuel P. Chaplain five dollars in money

I give and bequeath to my brother George Whitfield Chaplain five dollars in money

I give and bequeath to my step son Madison Osborn my chart and frame containing the Lords prayer and two split bottom chairs, which originally belonged to his father,

I give and bequeath to my step daughter, Dorcas E Hip two split bottom chairs which originally belonged to her father one bed quilt selected by herself and all my right title and interest in the East part of lot number eight (8) in Block number three (3) in the town of Plainfield in Henricks County State of Indiana, It is my will that after my estate is finally settled up that provided there is a remainder left not heretofore provided for, that it be given to my sister Emily Christiana Manning Court expenses and expenses of administration deducted at

Thereby nominate and appoint Samuel Rossitt to be trustee

Before me Nicholas S. Hadley Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas of the County, aforesaid personally came Harten Hadley one of the subscribing witnesses to the foregoing and hereto attached instrument of writing, who being by me first duly sworn, upon his oath deposes and says: That Mary Mariah Osborn the testatrix named in said instrument of writing, professing to be her last will and testament, did sign, seal, publish and declare the same to be her last will and testament on the day of the date hereof; that the said testatrix was at the said time, of the full age of twenty one years, and of sound and disposing mind and memory, and that she was not under coercion, compulsion or restraint and that she was competent to devise her property, And that the said testatrix so signed, sealed published and declared the same to be her last Will and Testament, in manner and form as aforesaid in the presence of aforesaid and of Noah W. Gossett and Hiram A. S. Green the other subscribing witnesses hereto, and that they each attested the same and subscribed their names as witnesses thereto, in the presence and at the request of said testatrix and in the presence of each other
