 Randolph County } Testament of Daniel Ogden
 deceased (late of Randolph County and State
 of Indiana) was duly proved before me Charles
 Conway Clerk of said Probate Court by the oath
 of Robert Millman one of the subscribing witnesses
 to said will

and Thomas Moorman & Nathan Hockett the
 Executors named in said will appeared and filed
 Bond in the sum of two thousand dollars with
 William Jay and Norton Moorman securities
 for the faithful performance of their duties as
 Executors aforesaid - Whereupon letters Testamentary
 on the said will were issued to the said Thomas
 Moorman and Nathan Hockett, authorizing them
 to administer the said Estate according to the said
 will and the said executors were duly affirmed
