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John Osborn

I John Osborn of Economy Wayne County Indiana. make
 this my last Will and Testament:

I give and bequeath to my wife Rachel my entire personal
 estate and my entire Real Estate being lots number Twenty Five
 (25). Twenty Six (26). Twenty seven (27) Fifty four (54) Fifty five (55)
 and fifty six (56). as numbered on the lot of the town of Economy
 Wayne County, Indiana and a lot of land in the South West part
 of Section Twenty eight (28) and also a lot of land in the South
 East corner of section Twenty nine (29) of Township Eighteen (18)
 Range Thirteen (13).

In witness hereof I have unto set my hand and seal this
 9th day of March 1874.

 subscribing witnesses thereto.


