My Indenture made and agreed upon this fourth day

of April in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred & three
Between Moses Raridon and his wife Ellena of Harrison County of the
State of Kentucky of the one part and David Osborn of the County of
the other part. Witnesseth that the said Moses & Ellena his wife for
and in consideration of the sum of sixty six pounds in hand paid
satisfied have granted bargained & sold and by their presents do grant bargain
and sell unto the said David Osborn his heirs and assigns a certain
tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in Harrison County on the
waters of Beaver Creek being a part of U. C. Conmicos Survey of 14,000 acres
and bounded as follows (viz) Beginning where Thomas Logwoods line begins
U. C. Conmicos line Survey formerly by then Colman at a beech & four
Sugar trees thence with said Logwoods line south sixty six poles to a beech &
three Sugar trees at the Posters Beginning corner thence running with former
Division line east two hundred & thirty one 1/4 poles to a stake thence north
sixty six poles to U. C. Conmicos line thence with said line to the Beginning
containing one hundred acres or more or less which said tract or parcel of
land the said Moses & Ellena his wife for them their heirs unto the said David
his heirs and assigns will forever warrant and defend and do further convey
out and agree further with the said David to warrant & defend the above
described parcel of land to him his heirs and assigns & assigns forever from all
and every person claiming the same In Testimony whereof we have here
