In the name of God amen Pius Albano of Washington County and State of Kentucky being in firm of body but of perfect sound mind and memory thanks be to God first and calling to mind the uncertainty of his life do make and constitute this my last will and Testament in the manner and form following My first recommendation my soul in the hands of God that I direct my body to be buried in a decent form according to the <sup>directions</sup> of my friends hereafter named secondly I give and bequeath unto my wife Elizabeth my negro boy named Stephen Henness all my slaves
