DECLARATION FOR MINOR.

STATE OF *Missouri*

COUNTY OF *Daviess*

On this *12th* day of *January* 18*59*, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid, *Robert J. Owings*

(1) guardian of *America Osborn* aged *20* years, minor child of *Jesse Osborn* - - - - - deceased, and being duly sworn according to law, declares that he believes the said *Jesse Osborn* was a *Private* in the company commanded by Captain *Joseph Redman* in the regiment of *Kentucky Militia* commanded by Colonel *England* in 18*12*, and that he on or about the *18* day of *18*, for the term of

and continued in actual service in said war for the term of fourteen days, and was honorably discharged at

He further declares that the said *Jesse Osborn* died on or about the *18* day of *18*, and that he had no widow living on the *3d* day of *March*, 1855, and that the said *America Osborn* is a minor child of the said *Jesse Osborn*, having been born on the *5* day of *October* 18*38*.

He further states that he is the legally-appointed guardian of the said minor child, and makes this declaration in *her* behalf for the purpose of obtaining the bounty land to which *she* may be entitled under the act approved 3d March, 1855. He also declares that (2) *no application has since been made for bounty land either by the Soldier, Widow or minor child*

AFFIDAVIT OF TWO WITNESSES.

We, *James Owings* and *Abner Osborn* residents of *Daviess County* in the State of *Missouri* upon our oaths declare that the foregoing declaration was signed and acknowledged in our presence; that

Jesse Osborn - - - - - the father of the said minor child, and who served as stated, died on the *18* day of *18*; that he left no widow who was alive on the *3d* March, 1855, and that the said minor child was born on the *5th* day of *October* 18*38*, and that they know the fact from the following: (3) *from personal knowledge record of family table exhibited to them and believed to be correct*

and they further declare that the said child is the *only* minor child of said *Jesse Osborn* - - - - - and that they are disinterested. (4)
